Pet Care Certificate (Level One)

Course access duration: Two months

Animal Handling

Recognise and learn how to handle pets:

- Learn about identifying animals by breed or type
- Understand about identifying animals as individuals
- Gain an understanding of their basic behaviour
- Understand how to handle and restrain them

General Pet Care

Identify the needs of pets and provide the best care:

- Learn about the nutrition and feeding of pets
- Find out about grooming
- Understand the principles of hygiene and cleaning

Infectious Diseases

Understand common diseases spread between pets and how to prevent them:
